


What? No! I'm on my way, off from the dentist's.


Good. Got rid of that pain?

Not really. You gotta give me some advice.





And Sometimes about Our personal lives ...




We were so good together ...

Then my pain episodes started ...





He saw me in pain, crying, and not being able to eat for a while ...

He started to freak out, because of...



After a while her pain episodes became more frequent and unpredictable.





It happened at work. Soon they started to degrade her position there...




And at parties.

She found the support, made the right choices regarding her job and career. She keeps her motivation in spite of her bumpy path..


She calls me once in a while and we laugh at our problems together.
